

Prospect High School PTSA Meeting

- Welcome and Introductions
 - Lubna Sheet called the meeting to order. Eight were present. Lubna motioned to approve the minutes posted online. Thomas Swidler seconded it and all were in favor.
- Student Council Report
 - Make a Wish Rally was last Friday. All wishes have been delivered.
 - 12 AP tests were paid for. Four bikes were given out. 5 Grad Night tickets and 5 Prom tickets were paid for.
 - PTSA donated money to purchase 9 Chrome books.
 - We Day works with an organization that helps third world countries. ASB is selling bracelets to donate money. This is their global project.
 - Spring Fling and Black Out dances are being planned. The Sadies may be an outdoor dance. They will change the DJ for the next dance. Prom is at the Tech Museum.
 - Jr.'s planning has started for senior prom 2016.
- Superintendent Report
 - We are going through a process to update the LCAP plan. It is an annual update.
 - Tomorrow a LCAP survey will go out to teachers, parents, and students. Hard copies of the survey will also be sent to give parents a chance to fill it out if they cannot do it online. Survey will be found on the Campbell School District site date posted TBA.
 - This year the survey is focused on this year's strategic goals. It is also looking for input and feedback.
 - The window will be open through March for the survey.
 - Our four strategic goals align with the eight state priorities. All schools plans are aligned which is a very helpful.
 - Feedback will be used for a draft of the LCAP for the four years.
 - We are looking to begin an Educational Foundation. If we know of someone that might be interested in helping it get started and being on the board, please let the superintendent know.

- Principal Report
 - It has been difficult to have a separate meeting for SSC. Ms. Hanson would like to roll SSC into PTSA with an agenda item to put at the

end of the meeting. PTAS times subject to change from 6:30pm to 8pm to accommodate SSC with PTSA meetings.

- Next year it will be an adjunct duty to get teachers to participate more in SSC.
- April 16, 17, 20, and 21 will be the Smarter Balance Testing dates.
- There will be practice tests going on to teach the students how to manipulate the tools needed for the test.
- The VAPA construction should be done at the end of the year. This summer there will be more construction and two programs using the facilities. One program is the Credit recovery summer class. It will be busy here.
- Treasurer Report
 - Thomas made a motion to approve the audit made on January 19th. It is the mid-year audit and there will be an end-of-year audit also. Lubna motioned to approve it. Danielle seconded it. All approved it.
 - The donation drive for Make a Wish did not bring in as much as last year. Only \$175.00 collected this year. ASB did have a gofundme account, but we might want to look at ways to get more donations for next year.
 - We donated \$2,400 to Make a Wish to buy Chrome books.
 - All mini-grants have been paid for.
 - We have a balance of \$26,996.32 as of 2/10/15.

 - We will re-address the donation drive for next year in May.
 - We will also look what parent nights we want for next year in May.
 - Need to work on PR for next year Make a Wish to be more successful.
 - Create pie Charts to better explain where funding goes.
