- Welcome and Introductions
  - Lubna Sheet called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Eight people were present. The minutes from last month's meeting were read. Joell Hanson motioned to approve them and Susan seconded them. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.
- Student Council Representative
  - This month is not as busy as October now that Homecoming is over.

  - PTSA may not be able to give the same donation because our membership is down.
