

## Prospect High School PTSA Meeting January 10, 2017 7:00PM

- Welcome and Introductions
  - Lubna Sheet called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Eight people were present. The minutes from last month's meeting were read. Thomas Swidler motioned to approve them and Susan seconded them. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.
- Student Council Representative
  - o No students were present.
- Principal Report
  - At some point this year, parents will be getting a survey from the SSC for the WASC accreditation requesting that parents become a part of the process by participating in focus groups.
  - The groups would look at data for programs that have been in place to see if the self-study represents our community.
  - Joell could do a presentation to look at data before the March or April PTSA meeting if we wanted.
  - o This part of the accreditation is a fourteen month journey.
  - The facilities committee presented to the board the needs schools have for repairs. They are in the process of prioritizing needs.
- Treasurer Report/Teacher Grants
  - o Our month end balance was \$21,836.39.
  - $\circ~$  The only expense this month was paying \$135 for the AP snacks.
  - Thomas motioned and we approved to spend up to \$150 for the SAT Boot Camp.
  - We also approved to spending up to \$200 to put something in all teachers boxes for Valentine's Day.
  - Five more teachers applied for grants. The total amount of the request was \$1,233.10. We approved all five.
- District Representative Report
  - o Danielle was not present.
- Membership Report
  - $\circ$  There were no changes to membership.
- SAT/ACT/Study Skills/PSAT classes
  - The SAT Boot Camp course and scores back night will cost about \$250 for the classrooms.
  - Thomas made a motion and we approved to spend the money for the boot camp.

- Parent Education Night
  - o Got College can do a presentation at a meeting. It lasts about an hour.
  - Danielle Pirslin also knows someone that can do an anti-bullying presentation.
  - o Anti-bullying was one of the lowest areas of interest on the survey.
  - o SAT Prep classes were the area of greatest interest on the survey.
- AP Information Night
  - AP Information Night was on January 9<sup>th</sup>. There was a good turnout and teachers appreciated the Togo's sandwiches.
- 8th Grade Parent Night
  - o It is on January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30pm.
  - o PTSA will have a table setup and speak to the group.
  - We might go to the home and school club meetings for EDS or Moreland Middle before the end of the year to draw in parent participation for next year.
